

Ride Safe Transit Guide for Your Ride

Getting you to where you need to be is our top priority, however we want you to be prepared for you visit and want to help with these few tips.

- 1. Be sure to review our passenger policy on our web page.
- 2. Speak with your incarcerated loved one prior to scheduling your visitation transportation to ensure that you are on the visitor's list.
- 3. Call the facility of which your loved one is housed to ensure that you are cleared to visit per facility protocol.
- 4. Be sure that you have the proper identification needed to visit per facility protocol prior to scheduling of your transportation.
- 5. Please be sure to know and adhere to facility visitor's dress code
- 6. Make sure that you have designated money (quarter/coins or dollar bills) for vending machine use during your visit.
- 7. Bring with you only items of which you will need for your visit.
- 8. Do not bring any weapons of any kind as no weapons are allowed on the transport vehicle.
- 9. Prepare all needed items for infant/toddlers as long rides can be a challenge for this age passenger.
- 10.Double check before transport pick-up that you are prepared for your ride to visit your loved one.
- 11.BE READY FOR AN EXCEPTIONAL RIDING EXPERIENCE WITH RIDE SAFE TRANSIT SO THAT YOU CAN PLAN TO VISIT YOUR LOVED ONE FOR MANY VISITS TO COME.
